SI = 66 % of GDP

DE = 60 % of GDP

AU = 70 % of GDP

HU = 66 % of GDP

HR = 66 % of GDP

IT = 134 % of GDP

## Credit ratings (S&P):

SI = AA - (stable)

DE = AAA (stable)

AU = AA + (stable)

HU = BBB (stable)

HR = BBB - (stable)

IT = BBB - (negative)

Beginning of February – SI donated to China medical equipment to combat Covid 19

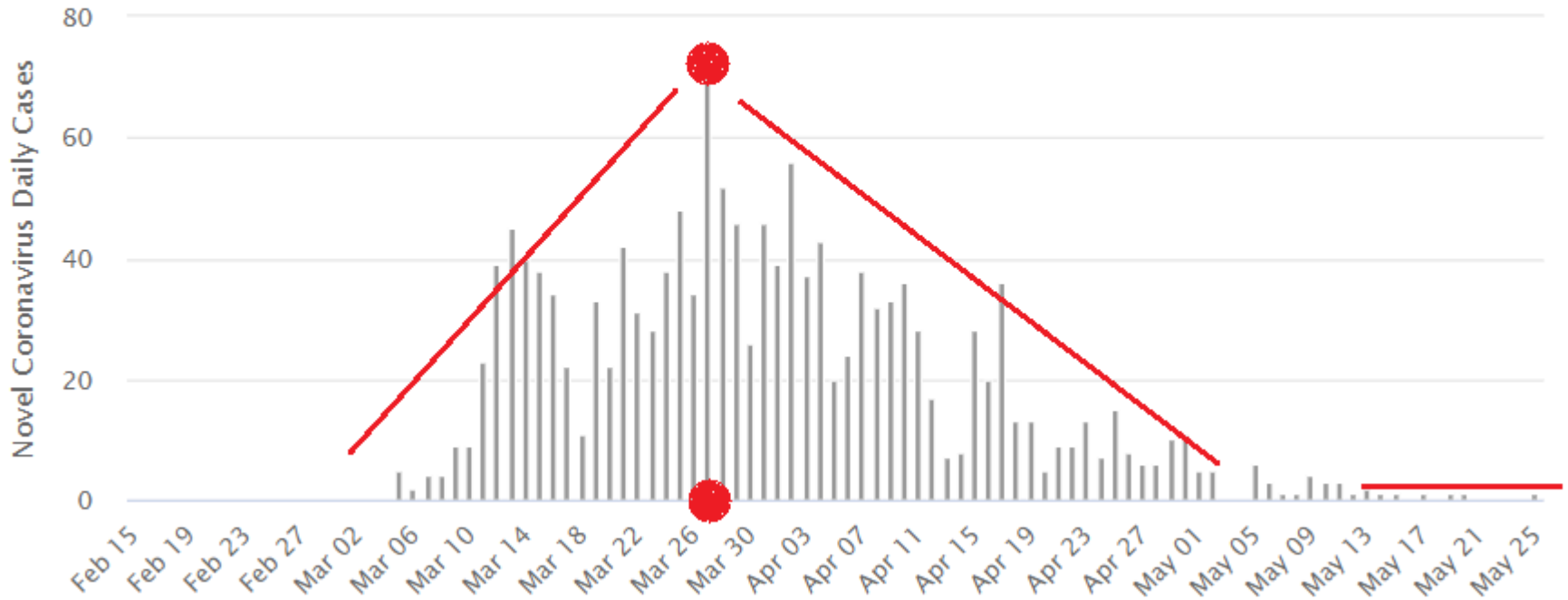
First case of Covid 19 – 5th of March

Daily New Cases

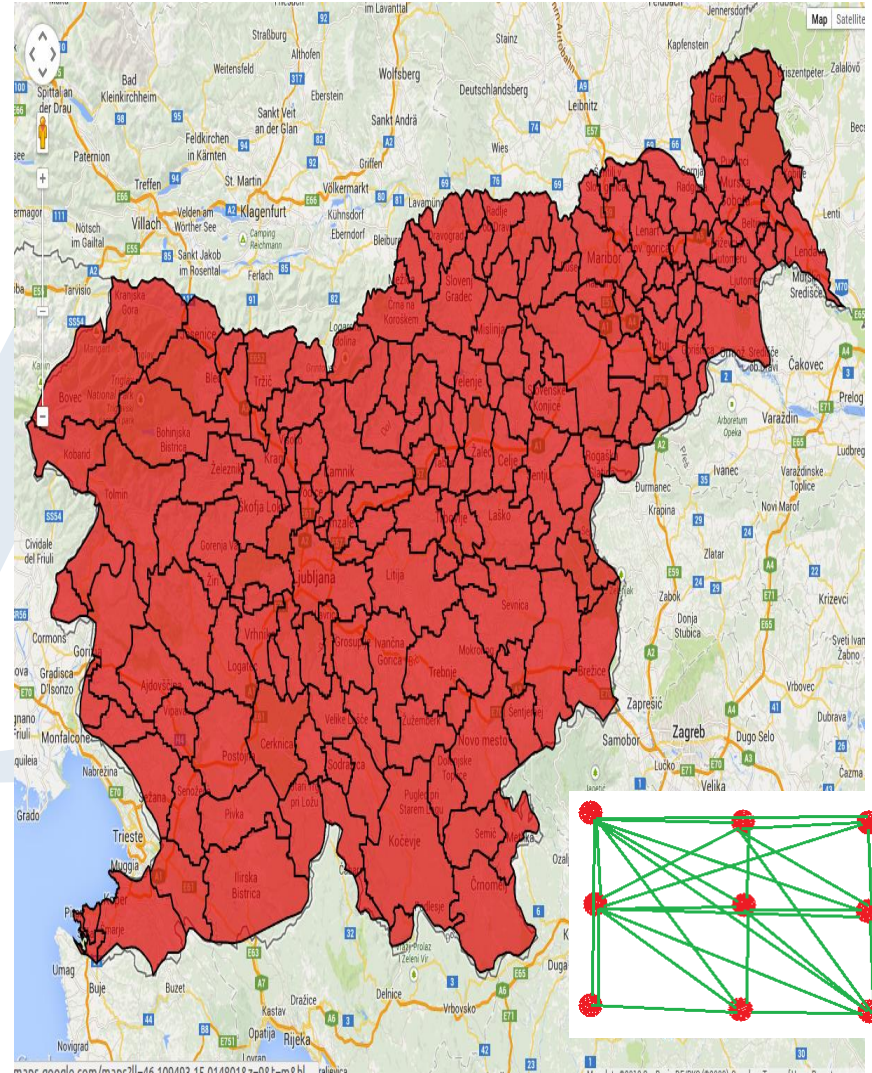


# Actions
