Macro-Policy Topology – Initial Considerations.

The paper seeks to answer a perennial question of what other country has successfully implemented the macroeconomic reform you suggest to me? Traditionally, two answers are offered in response: (i) there is no "one-size-fits-all approach," each country is unique and should be treated individually; (ii) an expert can point to a similar reform, which he has just guided in some other country.

Neither response is acceptable.

The paper suggests to approach this question in two steps: first, using formal classification techniques, differentiate countries based on their macro-indicators (the level of development, geo-politics, geography, common language, natural endowment, diversification, etc.); macroeconomic space (fiscal space, monetary space, reserve space); political cycle phase (before or after elections; political regime); risks (fiscal, debt-distress, monetary – interest rate/growth, external/tariffs); institutions (institutional strength index, vested interests, corruption, exchange rate regime, access to capital markets). Second, use an expert judgment.

It is quite possible is that there no reasonable answer to this question. What to do in this case?
